Tips for Emptying Portable Toilets

Waste from portable toilets contains bacterias and chemicals that can have harmful effects on health and the environment.

- Only dispose of lavatory waste at designated disposal stations.
- Never use a freshwater hose to rinse drains or portable toilets.
- Use gloves or hand sanitisers to prevent bacterial infections.
- Portable toilets are solely for pee, poo and paper. Only
 use toilet paper that is suitable for portable toilets.
- Use ecological and biodegradable cleaning products.
 Avoid using chlorine or cleaning products that have formaldehyde or phosphate.
- If possible, empty kitchen and shower water in other designated dump stations than for lavatory waste.
